**NORTHEASTERN COUNSELING CENTER** has an immediate opening for a full-time **Prevention Specialist** in the **Roosevelt** office.

We want to recruit a motivated individual who can interact with youth and adults in providing prevention and education services to a variety of community groups including workshops, presentations, training and alcohol/drug and other prevention awareness activities. Duties will include collecting and reviewing local data, developing, planning, and implementing evidence-based prevention policies and programs in the schools and community with the assistance of the NCC Prevention Team, schools and other community agencies and groups. It is essential that candidates possess a desire and ability to learn new material, have good written and verbal communication skills, be dependable, and have the energy and desire to make a difference in our community. This position will be required to attend out of area trainings, occasionally for up to a week at a time, travel frequently within Uintah, Duchesne, and Daggett Counties, and be willing to accommodate a flexible schedule, occasionally working early mornings, evenings, weekends, and holidays.

No formal training or college degree is required for this position. However, preference may be given for college course work in social work, psychology, health education, community education or community health services. Must have a high school diploma or equivalent; must be able to pass Criminal Background Screening; must possess a valid Utah Driver's License with good driving and safety record; must become SAPST certified within 6 months; must be at least 21 years of age and be tobacco-free. This is a full-time position with a generous benefit package. Salary is \$15.00/hr. Position is open until filled.
